Edmunds of Southampton County and state of
Virginia have bargained and sold unto James
Brambley of the said County Two Negroes slaves named
Solomon for the consideration of eighty one
pounds seven shillings Virginia money the receipt
whereof I do hereby acknowledge and I do by these
presents warrant and defend the title of the
said Negroes against my self my heirs and assigns
against all persons whatsoever to the said Brambley
his heirs and assigns for ever in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 23 day
of October 1707
