a straight line of marked trees to the Beginning to have
and to hold all and singular the above bargained
premises to him the said John Vick his heirs assigns
forever to the proper use and behoof of them and any
of them and the said Simon Vick at the time of making
and Delivering of these premises are lawfully seized of
the above land with the appurtenances thereto belonging
in fee simple and the said Simon Vick do for my self
my heirs and assigns forever warrant and defend the
said land and premises against all and all manner
of persons laying any just right or claim thereto
the said land is free and clear of all Incumbrances
whatsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto
