This Indenture made this seventh day of April
in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty
six between Jeffery Glover of the County of Brunswick of the one
part and Joseph Hill of the parish of Newport and County
of Stafford of the other part Witnesseth That the said Jeffery
Glover for and in consideration of the sum of fifty five
pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid the
Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit &
forever discharge the said Joseph Hill his heirs Executors &
Administrators have and each of them hath granted conveyed
gained sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed
and by these presents do and each of them doth grant convey
gain sell alien release enfeoff and confirm unto the
said Joseph Hill and his heirs a certain tract or parcel
of land situated lying and being in the said parish of Stafford
and County of Southampton containing by estimation one
hundred and fifty acres and bound according to the most
known antient and reputed bounds thereof together
with all houses woods ways Waters profits Commodities
