made this Twenty seventh
day of November one thousand seven hundred and eighty
seven between Elisha Whitney and Mary his wife and Shadrach
Corbet and Ann his wife of the County of Suffolk and City
of the one part and William Byghin Junior of the other part witness
eth that the said Elisha Whitney and Mary his wife of the County of
Suffolk and Shadrach Corbet and Ann his wife of the County
of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty pounds
to them in hand by the said William Byghin Junior of the County of
Southampton the receipt whereof we doth hereby acknowledge and
ourselves to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid &
by these presents for ourselves our heirs and assigns doth fully &
clearly and absolutely remise Release and forever quit claim
unto the said William Byghin and his heirs forever All such right
Title Interest and demand whatsoever to fifty acres of land
being the same more or less it being the whole four in proportion
of that Tract of Land that formerly belonged to Blythe Williams which
fell to Henry Williams and at his decease the said Tract of Land
fell to his sisters Vizt. Mary, Ann, Elizabeth and Sarah Williams
Beginning at Arthur Byghin's line Lights and Lower Long Lower
and Ledbiters Lower line is a long up Seacoast Swamp to the first
Station To then with all Flower Orchards Gardens woods ways
waters water courses and all other profits and advantages to the
same belonging or in any wise appertaining - To have to hold
all and singular the said land and premises with the appurtenan-
ces thereto belonging unto the said William Byghin and to his
heirs forever so that the said Elisha Whitney and Mary his wife
and Shadrach Corbet and Ann his wife nor their heirs Execu-
tors nor any person or persons whatsoever by from or under
them shall by any means hereafter have claim or demand any
estate right Title in or to the premises or to any part or parcel
of this said tract of Land they and they and every of them
shall be utterly excluded and debared for ever by these
presents and also the said estate Whitney and Mary his wife
and Shadrach Corbet and Ann his wife have hereunto set
their hands and seals This day and Year above Written
