the 27th day of November 1707. The fee simple estate

Twenty five Acres more or less and whereas the said

said County to make Acknowledgment of the same
Therefore we command and give in any two or more of you
go personally to the said Mary & receive her Acknow-
ledgment thereof & examine her privily and apart from
her said husband Whether she doth the same willingly
without the procurement or threats and whether she do
willing the said Indenture should be recorded in the Court
of Louthampton when you have examined her as aforesaid
you do then and plainly Certify us thereof under your
hands and seals & returning also to us this writ without
Sam. Keller clerk of our S^d Court at his office the 27th day
of November 1707 And in the 1st Year of the
Commonwealth
