in the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand seven hundred
Eighty Eight & The Thirteenth Year of our Independence
between Isaac Johnson of the County of Southampton State
of Virginia of the One part and Thomas Holiday of the
County and State aforesaid of the Other part Witnesseth
that the said Isaac Johnson for and in consideration of the
sum fifty Two — pounds current Money of Virginia to him
in hand paid by the said Thomas Holiday the receipt
whereof the said Isaac Johnson doth hereby acknowledge
he the said Isaac Johnson have granted Bargained &
sold aliened and Confirmed by these presents as good
bargain and sell alien and Confirm unto the said
Thomas Holiday his heirs and assigns forever One
certain Tract or parcel of land Situate lying & being
in the South side of Mottoway River in the County of
Southampton aforesaid containing by Estimation
One hundred & Fifty Acres be same more or less than
as follows to wit beginning at a large oak in the
