dependence between Isaac Johnson of the one part  
of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia  
and William Edmunds of the County aforesaid of the  
other part witnesseth that the said Isaac Johnson  
for and in Consideration of the sum of thirty five  
Pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand  
paid by the said Edmunds at beforehand making  
and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said Isaac  
Johnson doth hereby acknowledge and thereupon doth  
quit the said William Edmunds his heirs executors &  
Administrators hath granted bargained sold aliened  
Released and confirmed and by these presents doth  
grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said  
William Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract  
or parcel of land containing  
More or less it being part of Isaac Johnsons Land whereon  
he now lives situate and lying in the aforesaid County  
of Southampton and on the north east side of Duke
