Indenture made the twelfth day of
June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and eighty eight Between William Ellis and Elizabeth his
wife of the county of Sussex of the one part & Micah Ellis
of the county of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
pounds current money by the said Micah Ellis to the said
William Ellis in hand paid above before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof the said William Ellis
and Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge and acquit
and discharge the said Micah Ellis his heirs and assigns
forever by these presents they the said William Ellis and
Elizabeth his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened
confirm and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
alienate confirm unto the said Micah Ellis his heirs and
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the county of Southampton and on the
north side of Netoway River containing one hundred
acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth
Beginning at a pine in Olive Browner line thence along
her line to a small Dogwood a corner Thence along the
said Browner line to a large sweet gum on the banks of
Netoway River thence up the river as it meanders to
large pines on the side of the low grounds thence a
long a line of new marked trees to a live oak on the
side of a pond thence along a new line of marked trees
to a live oak a corner thence along a line of new marked
trees to the Beginning With all the uses Building Wood
ways water courses profits commodities and heredita-
ments whatsoever to the said land belonging & in any
wise thereto appertaining and the reversion and
reversions remainder and remainders Present and
profits thereof and all the Estate right title and
Interest of the said William Ellis and Elizabeth
his wife of in and to the same To have and to hold
all and singular the said Tract or parcel of Land with
the appertinances unto the said Micah Ellis his heirs
and assigns forever and the said William Ellis &
Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs
