and Benjamin Ruffin of the parish of Nottoway in the county
of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that for and in
consideration of the sum of fifty pounds current money
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin
Ruffin at or before the making and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof the said William Browne doth here
by acknowledge and thereof doth fully acquit and discharge
the said Benjamin Ruffin his heirs executors and adminis-
trators for ever by these presents he the said William
Browne hath granted bargained sold aliened released
confirmed and by These presents doth grant bargain
