after mentioned the proper Negroes of the said Patience
Newson at the time of Sealing and Delivering of these
presents by the said Patience Newson for them the said
Nathan Barnes and James Barnes to have or sell to the
best advantage and to apply the money arising from such
hire or sale of the negroes herein after mentioned first
to the payment of the debt aforesaid and the residue
according to the direction of the said Patience Newson
this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Patience Newson
in pursuance of the premises and for divers other consideration
her herunto moving but more especially for and in consideration
of the sum of Five shillings to her in hand paid on or before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof she
doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold and delivered
and doth by these presents bargain sell and deliver unto the said
Nathan Barnes and James Barnes and to their heirs and
assigns forever for the purpose aforesaid and for no other
intent or purpose whatsoever the following Negroes vizt
Tom Juaah Jim Natt David Black Jack and Jane the
proper negroes of the said Patience Newson herein
before named and every of them and all the right
title interest claim and demand whatever of her the
said Patience Newson of in and to the said Negroes &
every of them to have and to hold the said Negroes and
every of them unto the said Nathan Barnes and James
Barnes & to their heirs and assigns forever for the purposes
aforesaid to the only proper use & behoof of the said
Nathan Barnes and James Barnes their heirs and
assigns forever and the said Patience Newson for
herself her heirs Executors and Administrators the
said Negroes herein before particularly named
and every of them for the purposes aforesaid
