This Indenture To all People whom

paid by Hardy Lawrence of the said County in the Province
of Virginia the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
myself therewith fully satisfied paid and Contented and
thereof and of every part and Parcel thereof do Constitute
quit and discharge the said Hardy Lawrence his heirs
Executors Administrators for ever and by these presents
have given granted Bargained and sold aliened & confirmed
and by these presents do freely fully and absolutely give
grant Bargain sell alien Convey and Confirm unto him
the said Hardy Lawrence his heirs Executors Administrators
the said Hardy Lawrence his heirs Executors Administrators
two or assigns for ever one Mill properly Called a grist
mill and seat situate lying and being in the County of
Southampton and in the Province of Virginia on Black
Creek it being a Certain mill formerly belonging to
Giles Smalley and by him Given to Joshua Whitney & by
him given to his Son Giles Whitney & him be sold to
Hardy Lawrence then the said Hardy Lawrence agreed
with the above mentioned Henry Lee to rebuild the
Mill anew on Terms of his having the half part of the
said Mill which he has agreed to sell to the said Hardy
Lawrence to have and to hold the said Mill which
the said Henry Lee has granted and bargained with
all its appertenance privileges & commodities to the
same belonging as in any wise appertaining to him
the said Hardy Lawrence his heirs and assigns for
ever and to their only proper use benefit & behoof
his heirs Executors Administrators even and promise
his heirs and assigns that before the Enrolling of
these presents the true and lawful owner of
