more or less whereon being the land Tabitha Newsum now
liveth that is to say the said Tabitha Newsum shall have
the use of the said tract of land as her right & property
during her natural life and bounded as followeth begining
at a black gum in the reedy Branch from thence toward
oak corner tree in James Barhams line from thence to
a white oak a corner tree joining William Ellyrichs line
from thence to a sweet gum a corner tree in Joel Newsums line
from thence to a red oak a corner tree on the Anglicas-
road side from thence along the said road to the reedy
branch from thence along the various courses of the said
branch to the begining together with all houses orchards
woods under woods waters water courses profits commodities
advantages and appertinances to the same belonging join
