Windham do send greeting, know ye that I the said Estace-
Windham of the parish of Totoway in the County of Southampton
planter for and in consideration of the love good will and affection
which I have and do bear towards my loving daughter Mary Portice
and Kerly Portice her husband of the same Parish County
have given granted and by these presents do freely give and grant
unto the aforesaid Kerly Portice and Mary Portice their heirs &
assigns forever one Tract or parcel of land lying and being in
the aforesaid County containing by estimation fifty acres and
bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a pine a corner tree in
Thomas Deloacher line and then along the said Deloacher line
to a hickory a corner tree and from thence along the said line
to Cohers line to a pine a corner tree thence along the said
Cohers line to a Turkey Oak joining John Windhams line
then along the said Windham line to a pine a corner tree
then along the said line to a pine a corner tree then along
the said line to a white oak a corner tree then along a
line of marked trees to the first station and also the division
and divisions remainder and remainders rents and
services of the land and premises and every part & parcel
thereof with the appurtenances thereof and all all the
estate right title Interest claim and demand whatsoever
of the said Estace Windham have in and to the said land
premises and every part thereof to have and to hold all
and singular the said land above mentioned and
