 interruption from me or any person claiming for by
 or under me In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal this 1st day of the second month one thousand
 seven hundred and eighty nine,

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 13th day of July
 1789 this Deed for the emancipation of sundry Slaves therein

 ing and Obtaining of the same as Ann Myself might or will
 do were I personally present Upon the receipt of
 the same Acquaintances and other Sufficiently
 Discharges for me and in my name to make
 Sign Seal and Deliver as aforesaid one or more
