 Between Ananias Randall of the County of Southampton of
 the one part and Nathaniel Felt of Sussex County of the other part
 Where as the said Nath: Felt at the instance and request of the
 Ananias Randall hath lent him the said Randall the sum of
 Sixty pounds Current Money Now this Indenture Witnesseth that
 for securing and indemnifying the said Nathaniel Felt against
 all damages whatsoever that may happen by means of said Contract
 also for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings by the said
 Nathaniel Felt to the said Ananias Randall in hand paid at or
 before the Sealing and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the
 said Ananias Randall his heirs Executors and Administrators
 to the said Annt: Randall hath granted bargained sold aliened
 Confirmed and delivered by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell and deliver unto the said Nathaniel Felt his heirs and
 assigns for ever one negro Man Named Charles
