 Between Beverly Booth of the parish of Muttonway in County of Dor-
 set of the one part and Moses Booth Junr of the same parish and County
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said Beverly Booth for and
 on Consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Current money of
 Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Moses Booth at or before
 the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the
 said Beverly Booth doth hereby acknowledge and thereby acquit
 and Discharge the said Moses Booth his and assigns by these
 presents have granted Bargained and sold aliened released
 enfeoffed and confirmed and by these do grant Bargain sell
 alien releas enfeoff and confirm unto the said Moses Booth
 to his heirs and assigns a tract or parcel of land situate lying
 and being in the aforesaid parish of Muttonway and County
 of Southampton on both sides of the Light House Swamp Contain-
 ing one Hundred & Five Acres more or less and bounded
 as follows To wit Beginning at a line by the side of the said
 Swamp a corner follows Booth Junr land thence south
 fifteen Degrees West one hundred and sixty poles to a white
