This Indenture made this forth day of March In the year
 of our late Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine
 between Benjamin Warring and Mary his wife of Holloway in the
 County of Southampton of the one part and John Warring of the same
 parish and County planter of the part witnesseth that the said
 Benjamin Warring and Mary his wife for and in consideration
 of the sum of twenty pound Current money of Virginia the
 Benjamin Warring in hand paid by the said John Warring at or
 before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the Receipt
 whereof the said Benjamin Warring doth hereby acknowledge
 thereof acquit and discharge the said John Warring hath granted
 bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these
 presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto
 the said John Warring and to his heirs Assigns forever all that
 Tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid
 parish of Notaway in the County of Southampton on the south
 side of a branch called James es branch containing by
 estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or less
 and bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a pine in the
 mouth of a small branch called the line branch and up the
 said branch to a pine a line tree in the head thereof and from
 thence by a line of marked trees that divide this land from
 the land of the said Benjamin Warring to a dog wood marked
 tree in Henry Branches line thence west a long line of
 marked trees of the said Henry Branches to a pine a
 corner tree in the said Henry Branches line thence north
 a long line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree dividing
 this land from the said Henry Branch and Edmund Stephens
 land and from thence running a line dividing this
 land from the said Stephens land to a corner tree
 a black oak in Thomas Griffins line and from thence
