

This Indenture made this Nineteenth day  
of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and  
Eighty Eight Between Benjamin Holden of the County of Southampton  
of the one part and Henry Summell of the County aforesaid of the other  
part witnesseth the said Benjamin Holden for and in consideration  
of the sum of Twenty pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in  
hand paid by the said Henry Summell the receipt whereof he  
doth hereby acknowledge that he hath granted Bargained and  
Alene Enfeoffed and Conveyed and by these presents doth grant  
bargain and sell alien enfeoff and Convey unto the said Henry Summell  
his heirs and assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of land  
containing by estimation Sixty Acres more or less situated lying  
and being in the said County of Southampton and bounded as  
follows [to wit] Beginning at a Turkey Oak thence along to a  
White oak and so along to a Hickory and thence along to a  
Parsimmon tree and so along to a ruben apple tree and so along  
to a Parsimmon tree thence along to another Parsimmon  
tree and so along to a Cedar tree stump and so along down  
the various courses of a slack of water to a maple thence along  
down the various courses of the south side of Seacock Swamp  
to a Cypress thence along aline of marked trees in the said swamp  
to the beginning it being part of a patent of land granted to Mr  
Phillips the Twenty ninth day of August 1717 Containing 200 acres  
To have and to hold the aforesaid land with all houses and  
houses gardens woods ways and waters with all other rights  
and privileges profits Commodities and advantages whatsoever  
to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining unto  
him the said Henry Summell his heirs and assigns forever  
in as full and ample manner to all true intents & purposes  
and I do hereby further or otherwise promise and grant to give  
the said Henry Summell his heirs & assigns that the said  
land and every part and parcel thereof is free and clear  
from all other gifts grants or mortgages and all other  
incumbrances whatsoever in the which I do hereby transfer  
and oblige myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and  
Defend his my sale of all and singulare the premises
