 that if the debt interest and costs above mentioned shall not
 be paid by the said John Blow his heirs executors or admini-
 strators by the time afore said that then the said John
 Aschell his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall
 and lawfully take and sell the said Negroes or as
 many of them as shall be reasonable and necessary for the
 payment of the debt afore said and all costs attending the
 said affair for the best price that can be got for the said Negroes
 or Negroes and that he the said John Blow his heirs executors
 administrators shall and will warrant and maintain the
 Lawfull Title Claim or demand of such purchaser or pur-
 chaser to him or them their heirs or assigns for ever against
 him the said John Blow and his heirs and assigns all other
