by Isaac Worthington and Martha his wife parties thereto she being first
privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be Recorded —

This Indenture tripartite made this sixth day of April in the year of
Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine Between Landon Harris
of the County of Southampton of the first part Ann Jones widow of James Jones late
of the said County deceased of the second part and John Simmons of the same County
of the third part Whereas a marriage is shortly to be had and solemnized
between the aforesaid Landon Harris and the said Ann Jones and whereas
the said Ann Jones is possessed and intitled to certain lands slaves & personal
chattels as the widow and devise of her said late husband and also as of her
own right in these following slaves to wit Ned Beck Lucy and Cherry and
these following articles to wit five feather beds & furniture and Now this
Indenture witnesseth that as well for and in Consideration of the said
intended marriage and of the fortune of her the said Ann Jones exclusive
of the slaves and articles last mentioned which he the said Landon Harris
will be intitled to and receive by virtue of the said marriage and also for
and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings by the aforesaid John Simmons
to the said Landon Harris in hand paid before the sealing & executing
this present writing he the said Landon Harris for himself his heirs executors
and administrators doth hereby Covenant promise grant and agree to &c
with the said John Simmons for and on behalf and to the use of the said
Ann Jones her heirs and assigns in manner & form following that
to say That it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said Ann Jones
notwithstanding the intended Marriage or Coverture and whether
she be Covert or discover to make and execute any deed conveyance or will
in Writing or other disposition of the above named Slaves and their
Increase and the above enumerated articles and therein wholly
direct give limit or dispose of the same or any part thereof to such
person or persons as she may think proper and that the said Landon
Harris his heirs executors and administrators and all persons claim-
ing under him shall not either during the Marriage or at any
