confirm unto the said Benjamin Broch his heirs and assigns forever
one certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Sten-
County aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and ninety
one be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Robert
Harts Jesse Harts William Holliman Joseph Harts and Henry Harts
and also all trees Woods ~~and~~ under woods Common common of
