We the subscribers of the County of Southampton Virginia having under our
care two negroes (males) and a woman named Rose aged about fifty years
also Simon aged about thirty years whom we have heretofore held as
slaves but do hereby emancipate and set free and we do for ourselves
our heirs successors and administrators relinquish all our rights titles
Interests and Claims and pretensions of Claims whatsoever either to
their persons or to any estate they may hereafter acquire the above
Rose and Simon to enjoy their full freedom without any interruption
from us or from any person claiming for by or under us Insistants
whereof we have heretofore set our hands and seals this 27th day of the first
month one Thousand seven hundred and eighty nine
