

This indenture witnesseth that said Robert Vick in pursuance of the promise and favour shew Coues and consideration to him herewith moving but more especially for and in consideration of the aforesaid Sum of Tobacco due as the above mentioned times and one Shilling, and there hence paid on the sealing and delivering of these presents their receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath Bargained sold and Delivered and sold by these presents bargain and deliver unto the said James Edwards to his heirs or assigns the Land hereafter mentioned for the properties aforesaid & to all True intents and purposes what ever in as full a manner as the learned in the law can direct and the said Robert Vick for himself and his heirs as Bargain make buy and deliver unto said James Edwards or his heirs for the purposes aforesaid the Land hereafter mentioned containing containing by estimation five Acres and bounded as follows to wit (Beginning at a Corner tree of Simon Vicks Thence along Jiles Farmers line to William Husk line a white oak thence down the said Husk line to a path that goes to Joses Vicks where he now lives to Jordans Vicks line thence from the said Jordan Vicks line to the Beginning now in possession of the property of Robert Vicks and the Reversion or reversions Remainder and remainders right title Interest claim and Demand whatsoever of him the said Robert Vick then and to the same to have and to hold & Land unto the said James Edwards and his heirs the said Land to answer the Contents above shall and will warrant and forever Defend by these presents if not punctually paid at the time above mentioned then this Instrument of Writing to remain in full force Power and Virtue In Witness Whereof I have set my hand and seal the day and year above written -
