Isaac Johnson of Southampton County of the one part & William  
Edmunds of the aforesaid County of the other part witnesseth that the said  
Isaac Johnson for and in Consideration of the sum and sum current  
money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Edmunds  
the receipt whereof the said Isaac Johnson doth hereby acknowledge  
have granted Bargained and sold and by these presents do grant  
bargain and sell unto the said William Edmunds his heirs and  
assigns a certain Spring of running Water together with an  
Acre of Marsh land around the said Spring which said Spring of  
running water is the constant rising spring of the said Isaac  
Johnson and lies on the south east side of the aforesaid  
branch in Southampton County which access the Marsh land doth  
extend to the run of the said Horse Meadow branch and then  
up and down the run of the said Branch hence from the  
run of the said Branch to the high land both above and
