Sarah Bond of Southampton County of Virginia being fully persuaded that Freedom is the natural right of all mankind and that it is my duty to do unto others as I would be done by in the like situation and having under my care one Negro Woman named Mouring aged about Twenty Years I hereby emancipate and set free the above named Negroe and as for my self my heirs Executors and administrators relinquish all my Right title interest and Claim or pretension of Claim whatsoever either to her person or to any Estate she may hereafter Acquire without any Interruption from me or any Person Claiming for by from or under me In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this eighth day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty Nine
