I James Jones of Southampton County Virginia being fully persuaded
that Freedom is the Natural right of all Mankind and that it is my
duty to do unto others as I would be done by in the like situation
and having under my Care One Negro Man named Ned about fifty
Years which I have hitherto for held as Slave I hereby emancipate and
set free the above named Slave and do for my self my heirs Executors
and Administrators relinquish all my Right Title Interest and claim or
pretension of Claim whatsoever either to his Person or any estate he may
hereafter acquire without any Interruption from me or any Person
claiming for by from or under me In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and seal this 5th day of the Sixth Month in the
Year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine
