This Indenture made and done this 9th day of March in

the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine Between John
Rochelle of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
Sarah Jackson Deary Beal and Mary his wife David Spencer and Mary
his wife and William Ford and Elizabeth his wife of the County and State aforesaid
and also Elizabeth Spencer and Anna his wife and Jesse Spencer and Rachel his wife
of the County of Johnston and State of North Carolina of the other part testifies

that the said Sarah Jackson Deary Beal and Mary his wife David Spencer and Mary
his wife William Ford and Elizabeth his wife Elizabeth Spencer and Anna his wife
Jesse Spencer and the said his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Twenty
Seven pounds of good and lawful Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by John
Rochelle the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and own themselves
fully Content and satisfied therewith and thereupon have bargained sold and
delivered and by these presents do bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto the
said John Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever a Certain Tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton Part of a patent first
granted Richard Vick bearing date the 1st day of July 1782 and by his
son Arthur Vick conveyed by deed of Bargain and sale to Samuel Spencer
the said said hearing date the 10th day of October 1782 and recorded the
same day in the County Court of Southampton is the said Samuel Spencer by

Arthur Vick and Elizabeth his wife the parties thereto whose Boundaries are
the aforesaid said are as follows Vizt. Beginning at a gum in William
Registers line thence by registers Line South fifty degrees east thirty three pole
to white oak in John Gurleys land thence by the said Gurleys line south
Twenty Degrees east eight pole to a live oak thence south east one
hundred and twenty six pole to a live oak a Corner of the said Gurley
thence south Twenty Degrees east fourteen pole to a gum a Corner of
Nicholas Gurleys land thence south twenty three degrees west seventy
four pole to persimmons and gum in Williams Hatfields line thence by
the said Hatfields line north forty eight Degrees West one hundred
forty six pole to a pine thence north seventy five Degrees west twenty
pole to a Turkey oak in Thomas Edwards line thence by a line of
marked trees to the beginning with all Woods underwoods Commons
profits Commodities advantages Emoluments & Hereditaments
whatsoever unto the said Tract or parcel of Land belonging or
in any wise appertaining or upon the same growing happening
or arising and also the reversion Residues Remainder and Remainder
& into and issues of the premises and every part and parcel
thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Rochelle
