his Indenture made the 10th day of August in the year four thousand seven hundred and eighty nine Between Burrell - Newick of Wake County No. Carolina and Newick of Southampton County Virginia Witnesseth that the said Burrell Vick for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Newick Vick at or before the writing and delivering the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge he the said Newick Vick the said Burrell Vick each hereby acquit and discharge each bargained sold and aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Newick Vick his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of parcel of land lying and being in the above mentioned County of Southampton - Containing by estimation Three hundred acres more or less bounded as follows To wit beginning at the mouth of the Hollypond branch thence running up the various courses of the said branch to the line of the said the property of Henry Post and Mary his wife thence in that line to the said Burrell Vicks James Barnes and Jonathan Givens thence in the said Barnes line to the Cypress Swamp thence up the various courses of the run of the said Swamp to the beginning together with all the appurtenances thereto To have and to hold all & singular premises of the above bargain to him the said Newick Vick his heirs and assigns forever to the proper use and behoof of them and every of them and the said Burrell Vick at the time of sealing and delivering of these presents am lawfully seized of the other land with the appurtenances thereto belonging in fee simple and I the said Burrell Vick for my self
