Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the Just and full sum of fifty
pounds Current money of Virginia by the said Jordan Denson to them
in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof the said William Gray and Mary his wife doth hereby acknow-
ledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Jordan Denson his heirs
and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied
Contented and paid they the said William Gray and Mary his wife
have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released storer
delivered and Confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant bargain
sell alien enfeoff released storer deliver and Confirm unto the said
Jordan Denson and to his heirs and assigns forever and their Griffe
mill with its appurtenances and the messuages tract and parcel
of land therunto belonging situate lying and being in the County
of Southampton and parish of Wotton aforesaid
