in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents to the

ledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Jordan Denson his heirs
and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied
Contented and paid they the said William Gray and Mary his wife
have granted bargained sold alined enfeoffed released set over
delivered and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien enfeoffed release set over deliver and confirm unto the said
