Jacob Jeyner Just. of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Henry Love Silas Love and Mary his wife Eleanor Love & Samuel
Slade for and in consideration of the just & full sum of nine pounds
nine shillings Current money of Virginia by the said Jacob Jeyner
to them in hand paid before the executing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof the said Henry Love Silas Love & Mary his
wife Eleanor Love and Samuel Slade doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and discharge the said Jacob Jeyner his heirs &
assigns forever and themselves therewith fully & entirely satisfied,
contented and paid they the said Henry Love Silas Love & Mary
his wife Eleanor Love and Samuel Slade hath granted bargained
sold aliened in feoffed released & delivered and confirmed
by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release
retn or deliver and confirm unto the said Jacob Jeyner & to his heirs
and assigns forever all that messuage tract and parcel of land
situate lying and being in the County of Southampton & parish
of Netoway aforesaid on the east prong of Netoway Swamp
and being part of a tract of land devised to the said Henry
Love and Silas Love by their father Elias Love Deceased
