This Indenture made this Tenth day of December 1789 and
thirteenth anniversary of the American Independence Between William Sewall of Hampton
County and State of Virginia of the one part and William Vaughan of the aforesaid
County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Sewall for &
in consideration of the sum of Fifty five pounds current money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said William Vaughan before the sealing
and delivery hereof the receipt Whereof the said William Sewall doth hereby
acknowledge and thereof doth acquit the said William Vaughan his
heirs executors & administrators hath Granted Bargain & Sold along
released and Confirmed and by these Presents do bargain sell alien &
Conform unto the said William Vaughan his heirs and assigns for
ever one certain Tract parcel or Division of Land containing by estima-
tion one hundred and ninety acres be the same more or less Situate
lying and Being in the County aforesaid and Bounded as follows
to wit Beginning at a hickory & corner tree in William Hillygreen
Land thence N. Twenty five Degrees West sixty poles to a pine tree
thence for a small Branch thence forty degrees East Two hundred
and twenty eight poles to a red oak by the side of a main Road
thence S. Fifty Degrees East 47 poles to a black Oak thence
S. 20 Degrees East one hundred and twenty eight poles formerly
