 widow of Thomas Dyer of the same part witnesseth that the said Joseph  
 Mary Britt for and in consideration of the sum of six pounds Current money of Virg-  
 in land paid by the said Mary Stephenson to the said Joseph Britt before the sealing whereof  
 she presents the receipt whereof the said Joseph Britt doth hereby  
 acknowledge himself therewith to be paid and thereof doth acquit  
 and discharge the said Mary Stephenson her heirs to forever by these  
 presents hath granted bargained sold & confirmed and by these presents  
 doth Bargain sell and Confirm unto the said Mary Stephenson her  
 heirs to certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation  
 sixteen acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth the  
 intent and meaning of this Indenture respecting the bounds is  
 that the said Joseph Britt have sold and by these presents doth  
 promise and grant that the said Mary shall have all the land the  
 south side of a Branch or dividing line Between William Stephenson  
 Govt. and the said Mary Stephenson according as before mentioned the most  
 known ancient and reputed Bounds thereto also the river & threes  
 remainder and remainders to have and to hold the said tract  
 or parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances therunto  
 Belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold unto the  
 said Mary Stephenson her heirs forwds defend the title claim or  
 demand of any person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof I have  
 hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written
