

This Indenture made this eighth day of Dec^r in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine Between Micajah
 Holliman of Southhampton County of the said and John Williamson of the same
 County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Micajah Holliman for &
 in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Pounds Current money
 of Virginia the receipt whereof the said Micajah Holliman doth hereby
 acknowledge hath granted Bargained sold aliened, enfeoffed and Conferred
 and by this presents doth grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto
 the said John Williamson all that tract and parcel of Land and Premises
 with the appurtenances situate lying, and being, in the County of Southhampton
 containing three hundred and seventy Acres be the same more or less and
 bounded as follows Beginning in Barbacoe Swamp at the mouth of
 pasture neck branch thence up the various Courses of the said pasture
 neck branch to a corner of Deft Harts line thence a new Survey south
 forty seven Degrees west forty pole to a pine thence south seventy one
 degrees west fifty two pole to a pine thence north thirty three degrees
 west sixty four pole to a turkey oak thence north eleven Degrees east
 seventy six pole to a white oak a Corner of Charles Sadlers land thence
 along his line north twenty nine Degrees East thirty poles thence north
 forty seven Degrees East eighty six pole to a black Jack thence south
 seventy three Degrees East one hundred and eight pole to a sapras in
 the old line by the side of the old field thence along the old ancient
 line to a small branch thence Down the branch to the main run of
 Barbacoe Swamp thence down the run of Barbacoe to the joining
 mouth of pasture neck branch one hundred and seventy five Acres
 of the said being part of a patent of granted Francis Williams on the
 14th of July 1701 Survey five acres being part of a patent granted
 Arthur and Doct^r Williamson the remainder one hundred and
 seventy Acres being a patent granted Micajah Holliman the twenty
 sixth day of December 1705 To have and to hold the afore-
 said land with all houses out houses Gardens Woods ways & waters with
 all other rights and privileges profits Cammories & advantages
 whatsoever to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining
 unto him the said John Williamson his heirs and assigns forever
