This Indenture made this fourteenth day of January one thousand seven hundred & ninety Between John Thomas Blow, William Thomas, & Thomas Naughton Executors of the Last Will and Testament of Richard Blow Deceased of the County of Southampton of the one part Joseph Gray Blunt of the Parish of St. Lukes and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Thomas Blow, William Thomas & Thomas Naughton for an insaturation of the Sum of three hundred and sixty pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Gray Blunt as or upon the delivery & delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof they the said John Thomas Blow, William Thomas & Thomas Naughton doth hereby Acknowledge & thereof Request and Discharge the said Joseph Gray Blunt his heirs Executors and Administrators hence by their presence they the said John Thomas Blow, William Thomas and Thomas Naughton doth grant Bargained sold aliened release & confirmed and by these presents doth grant Bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Joseph Gray Blunt his heirs and assigns forever one plantation parcel or tract of land situate lying and being on the south side of Potomac River on Bush Horn road the same being purchased by Miles Cary Dec^r of Mottoway Indians and by Miles Cary Executors sold to Richard Blow Dec^r By deed bearing date the ninth day of May One thousand seven hundred
