This Indenture made this ninth day of January one thousand
seven hundred and ninety between Henry Jury Esq^r of the Parish of St Luke
and County of Southampton of the one part and Peter von Jury of the County
aforesaid on the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Jury Esq^r doth
give and Bequeath to the said Peter von Jury for the Insealing and Delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof the said Henry Jury Esq^r doth confess
acknowledge and the said Henry Jury Esq^r for his heirs Executors adm^rs
thereof and every of them doth and discharge by these presents hath given
granted and bequeathed and doth and confirmed and in and
by these presents doth fully and absolutely grant give and bequeath
confirm and confirmed the same unto the said Peter von Jury
his heirs Executors administrators and assigns one certain tract of land
in his possession now being, his by Virtue of this said Indenture made
between the said Henry Jury Esq^r and the said Peter von Jury for the
transferring, possession to a full right and title to the said Peter von Jury
of the said land situate lying and being in the parish of St Luke
and County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred
forty acres be the same more or less being Bounded as followeth
to wit Beginning at a gum on the North side of plowman Swamp
just below the mouth of a small Branch a corner here of Edward
Pates Land thence by Pates line North fifteen Degrees East fifty
four pole to a red Oak then North west ninety eight pole to a pine
then North sixty Degrees west twenty five pole to a white Oak
then West thirty six pole to a white Oak then South twenty
five Degrees west ninety two pole to a red Oak then
