

This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of October in the year of our Lord
 Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between John Simmons of William Hines
 County of Southampton of the one part and William Hines of the same County of the other
 parties witnesseth that as well for securing the sum of Two hundred and ninety
 three pounds nineteen shillings and ten pence Specie and Interest arising from
 the date hereof due and owing by the said John Simmons to the said William Hines
 and all other sums of Money that is now due or may hereafter become due from the said
 John Simmons to the said Hines as also for and in Consideration of the sum of five shillings
 to him the said John Simmons in hand paid by the said William Hines at or
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John
 Simmons doth hereby acknowledge and he doth therefore by these presents grant
 slaves with their increase from the date hereof to w^t Thos & willl. Simons Esq: and
 Julius Peter Ben Myear Tiller Charlotte Tunney and Veney also Twenty five
 head of cattle eleven Sheep fifty hogs five Horses four Teacher Boys & furniture
 four walnut Tables and all my other House hold and Kitchen Furniture I have
 and to hold to the said William Hines and to his heirs and assigns to
 the only proper use and behoof of the said William Hines his heirs and
 assigns forever In D^rught nevertheless and upon this especial trust and
 confidence that the said William Hines his Heirs or assigns shall at
 any time after the 26th day of October next ensuing the date hereof at any
 time and place as he or they may think proper or sooner if the said John
 Simmons request the same sell at public Action for the best price that
 can be got giving due and public notice of such sale the aforesaid and hereby
 Accepted Slaves and other articles to raise a sum of money sufficient to pay
 and satisfy the said William Hines his heirs and assigns the aforesaid sum
 of Two hundred and ninety three pounds nineteen shillings and ten
 pence Specie with interest from the date of these presents also all other
 moneys that is now or may hereafter become due and owing from the said
 Simons where s^r Hines and retain the same in his or their hands for
 that purpose and all surplus after also deducting the incident charges
 of their writing and those attending the sale the said William Hines
 his heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby Covenant and
 promises to pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Simmons
 his heirs or assigns onto his or their Order In witness
