 Bill Marks my son two foal Mares Eleven Head of Cattle Six Sows Six Pigs —
 Five Sheep my proper Bear Clark Fox Feather Beds and furniture two
 Chests two Spinning wheels one flax wheel one loom and gear with all my
 other Household and Kitchens Furniture and Plantation Utensils To
 have and to hold to the only proper use and behoof of him the said —
 John Marks his heirs or assigns forever and I the said Richd Marks
 do by these presents for myself my heirs executors &c Covenant bargain
 and sell and promise to warrant and forever defend the title of the above
 articles to the said John Marks his heirs and assigns forever against
 the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty seventh day of January
 one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety.
