This Indenture

made this 3<sup>th</sup> day of April in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety between Joel Newsum and Nancy, his wife of Southampton County, of the one part and Joseph Marks of the same County, of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joel Newsum and Nancy, his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in hand already paid the receipt whereof the said Joel Newsum and Nancy, his wife do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released confirmed and by these presents doth bargain and sell release and confirm unto the said Joseph Marks his heirs and assigns for ever one certain Tract or Parcel of Land Situate lying and being on the North side of the three Creeks in the aforesaid County formerly belonging to William Barker containing by estimation two hundred and thirty eight acres be the same more or less it being the Tract or parcel of Land that the said Metisum formerly purchased of the Executors of William Barker did To have and to hold all and singular the said Land and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Marks his heirs and assigns forever to the only use and behoof of him the said Joseph Marks his heirs and assigns forever and well for ever warrant & defend the same

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from Claim Challenging or demanding of any person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and Date above written
