 to wit Archr. Bob and Willis To have and to hold the said
 bargain & promise unto the said John Dawson his heirs and assigns
 forever But upon this express proviso in trust and Confidencethat
 the said William Jarrell the he the said John Dawson shall
 make sale of the aforesaid Negroes to wit Archr. Bob & Willis
 at any time after the fifteenth day of September next and out
 of the Money arising from the sale first to satisfy the aforesaid
 sum of two hundred and thirty five Pounds with Interest as aforesaid
 and after discharging the said Debt and Interest to pay the balance
 unto the said William Jarrell and the said William Jarrell for himself
 his heirs executors and administrators doth grant and agree with
 the said John Dawson that he shall have a claim to the said
 Negroes to wit Archr. Bob and Willis aforesaid according
 to his agreement with the said John Dawson In witness
