This Indenture made the eleventh day of December in the year of our

sum of five shillings the receipt of which he acknowledge hath ingenuously
alived unfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant and
confirm unto the said Arthur Whitehead his heirs and assigns all that certain
parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the
south side of Notaway River containing five hundred and forty acres
more or less formerly the property of John Whitehead deceased and broung by
the lines of Mary Whitehead Nicholas Maget Henry Turner and Mr.
Allen with all houses Edifices hereditaments and appurtenances what-
soever to the said Mysage or tenement belonging or in any way appertaining
and the Revision and Reversion Remainder and Remainders unto
services full and singular the said premises also six Negresses
and Indian Girls Jordan Abby Jacob and all the other personal
estate which he hath now in possession formerly the property of John
Whitehead deceased to have and to hold the said Mysage or tenement
land and premises and other estate above mentioned hereby granted
conveyed with their appurtenances unto the said Arthur Whitehead
his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Whitehead for him
self his heirs Executors and Administrators both covenant promises and
grant to and with the said Arthur Whitehead his heirs and assigns held
and lawfully may from henceforth forever peaceably and quietly have
hold possess and enjoy the said Mysage or tenement and other
estate above mentioned to be hereby given and granted with the
and every of their appurtenances clear and discharged or well and
sufficiently saved and kept harmless and from all other gifts
