To whom it may Concern Knowledge that I Arthur Whitehead of Southampton County from a full conviction of the serious impropriety of Slavery do hereby Emancipate and set free from a state of bondage the following slaves Vizt Judith Natt Pinfey Jordan Abby Jacob the three last named being in a state of Minority I Defend the Guardian Care of them till they arrive to the age of twenty one and I do hereby release them entirely free from a state of Slavery from now mine or any other person by the authority of our Constitution and act of Assembly for that purpose according to the true intent of their presence to all intents and purposes In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal the 9th Day of April 1790

This Indenture made this seventh day of July in the year five hundred and eighty seven hundred and ninety Between Barnaby Drake Sr. and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Arum Drake of the County and state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Barnaby Drake Sr. and Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of five pounds good and lawful money of the state aforesaid already in hand paid them by the said Arum Drake the receipt of which said sum the said Barnaby Drake Sr. and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge and themselves their heirs and assigns fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid both Bargain and aliance enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm unto the said Arum Drake his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in the
