 that the said William Whitehead for and in consideration of the sum
 of six shillings to him in hand paid by the said John Barrow Nicholas
 Maget Arthur Whitehead and James Wilkinson the receipt whereof
 he doth hereby acknowledge and for securing the payment of the
 aforesaid debt with interest agreeable to the aforesaid Bonds hath
 bargained sold and delivered and by these presents hath bargained
 sold unto the said John Barrow Nicholas Maget Arthur Whitehead
 and James Wilkinson their heirs Executors Assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid
 on the north side of Motoway River containing by estimation seven hundred
 and ten acres and bounded as is expressed in a patent granted to Henry
 Browne deceased bearing date the 13th day of March in the thousand seven-
 hundred and fifty five and is the land purchased by Thomas Blunt
 deceased of the said Henry Browne Esqrs and by the executors of the said
 Thomas Blunt deceased as is directed in his last will & testament
 bearing date the 2th of Sept. 1777 was sold at publick auction to Jesse
 Whitehead who was put in possession thereof but before the deeds of
 conveyance were perfected the said Jesse Whitehead died intestate and
 without issue by means whereof the title of the said lands and premises
 are descended and come to the said Arthur Whitehead and was conveyed
 to him by the executors of the said Thomas Blunt deceased by Indenture
 bearing date the 10th day of December 1784 and by Indenture bearing
 date the 10th day of Decr. 1784 The said lands were conveyed to the said
 William Whitehead reference being had to the several conveyances to
 seven Negroes (to w^t) Moll Lucy Mrs Jean Andrew Tom and Peter
 also sixty head of cattle and fourteen head of horses to have and to hold
 the said Bargained premises to the said John Barrow Nicholas Maget
 Arthur Whitehead and James Wilkinson their heirs Executors
 and assigns forever but upon this express proviso in trust & conference
 for the said William Whitehead his heirs Executors & assigns that they the
 said John Barrow Nicholas Maget Arthur Whitehead and James
 Wilkinson their heirs Executors & assigns shall make sale of the said
 lands slaves and personal estate as aforesaid in or before that
