of the County of Southampton having in my possession several
Slaves and being conscious of the Injustice of Depriving my fellow
Creatures of their natural right from God do hereby emancipate
and set free the following Negroes Peter Jeph and Selby in
the following manner Peter shall be free in the first day
of January 1791 Jeph shall be free in the thirtyeth day
of December 1791 and Selby shall be free in the thirtyeth
day of December 1807 and I do by these presents Declare them
and their posterity forever fully and entirely delivered from
me and my heirs executors administrators and assigns in the
fullest sense to all intents and purposes according to
