This Indenture made this eleventh Day of February in the  
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety and in the Chancery  
of the Common wealth between Henry Jones and Peggy his wife of the  
County of Southampton of the one party and William Milner of the same  
County of the other party witnesseth that the said Henry Jones & Peggy  
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds current  
money to him in hand paid by the said Mr. Milner the receipt whereof  
he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted sold aliened released and con-  
firmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release &  
confirm unto the said William Milner and to his heirs and assigns all that  
plantation tract or parcel of land and premises with all and every the  
appertinences thereto now in the Tenure and Occupation of the said  
Milner and to his heirs and assigns lying and being in the County aforesaid  
Containing by estimation sixty Acres be the same more or less Bounded  
by the run of Black Creek lands of Stephen Lankford Hardy —  
Laurence and Capt Turner (or as is expressed in Lankfords Deed to Jones)  
and all houses and houses edifices Buildings Yards Gardens orchards  
trees ways waters water Courses profits Commodities and appertinences to  
the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining  
therevpon and Powers executors & remainder and remainders rents and Profits  
and profits thereof and all the estate right title Interest use Trust  
Possession property Claim or demand whatsoever of him the said Henry  
Jones and Peggy his wife of in and to the same and every Part thereof  
and dues Evidences and Writings touching or in any wise concerning  
the same To have and to hold the said Plantation tract or parcel  
of land and premises with the appertinences unto the said Mr. Milner  
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Jones and Peggy his  
wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators doth hereby convey  
not manesse and grant to and with the said Mr. Milner his  
heirs and assigns by these presents that the said Henry Jones and  
Peggy his wife hath hereby granted unto the said William Milner  
his heirs and assigns forever against the title Claim or Demand of  
any person or persons whatsoever and shall and will warrant and  
defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Henry  
Jones and Peggy his wife hath hereunto set their hands and  
Seals the day and year above written
