Scott which he the said Thomas Ricks is Justly indebted to the said
Joseph and W Scott and to Joseph Scott and honestly deserves to receive
and pay to them and for and in the further Consideration of the sum
of five shillings like money to the said Thomas Ricks in hand
paid by the said Joseph Scott at and before the sealing and delivery
of this the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and thereof
and for my part thereof do exonerate and discharge the said Joseph
and W Scott and Joseph Scott their heirs executors and administrato-
rs of the said Thomas Ricks have granted bargained sold and
Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm
and affect us forever a certain tract or parcel of land
