and pay to them and for and in the further consideration of the sum  
of five shillings like money to the said Thomas Richs in hand

of this receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and thereof  
and every part thereof do exonerate and discharge the said Joseph  
and W Scott and Joseph Scott their heirs executors and adminis-  
trators & the said Thomas Richs have granted bargained sold and  
Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm  
to the said Joseph and Wm Scott and Joseph Scott their heirs  
and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land
