This Indenture made this Twenty fourth day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety Between J. J. Pond of the County of Southampton of the one part and Richard Pond of the aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth that as well for securing the payment of the sum of forty pounds now owing from the said John Pond to Richard Pond payed at the twenty fifth of December next with interest from the date unto the said Richard Pond as also for and In consideration of the sum of five shillings to the said John Pond in hand paid before the sealing and Delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Pond hath and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Richard Pond and to his heirs and assigns one Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the fork of Round Hill Swamp and the ready branch and by a Direct line from a gum in Round Hill to a pine in the ready Branch containing sixty three and half acres more or less the land purchased by the said John Pond of William Browne and Com mited to record by Deed in the County of Southampton Referred being therein to hold in any more fully appear to have and to hold the said Tract of parcel of land with the reversions and reversions remainder and remainders right title and Interest of the said John Pond or his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Richard Pond his heirs and assigns forever In trust never the less and upon this Special confidence that the said Richard Pond his heirs or assigns shall after the twenty fifth day of Decr next expiring the date hereof at such time as he or they shall think
