This Indenture made this ninth day of May in the year
 of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety Between
 Richard Marks and Sally, wife of the parish of St Lukes & County
 of Southampton of the one part and Richard Blow of the Town of Ports-
 mouth of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Marks &
 his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds
 specie current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
 Richard & Blow the receipt whereof he the said Richard Marks
 doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain and sold and
 by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Rich^d
 Blow and his heirs and assigns forever an certain tract and
 parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid
 parish of Saint Lukes and County of Southampton containing
 one hundred and Sixty eight acres and bounded as follows to wit
 Beginning at a pine in Randall's Newsums line a corner
 of Richard Marks Jun^r Land thence along the Sth Newsums
 line South thirty east thirty two poles to a pine thence
