 same sold at public auction for the best price can be had giving due
 notice of such sale of the aforesaid property and with the money
 arising thereby retain pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of five
 hundred and thirty one pounds and the Interest arising from above
 date and the charges attending such sale and the recording this
 Indenture to the said Daniel Simmons his heirs or assigns & all over
 plus the said Daniel Simmons his heirs executors & administrators
 with hereby Covenant promise and grant to pay or cause to be paid
